Smell gas. Act fast. How do you know if you have a natural gas leak? Natural gas has no odor. But a chemical is added to it to give it the scent that smells like rotten eggs. Sometimes leaking gas creates a white cloud, mist, or fog. A natural gas leak can also make a hissing or whistling sound. If you smell, see, or hear the signs of a gas leak, act fast.

DOs

- Tell a trusted grown-up if you think you smell, see, or hear a gas leak.
- Get out of the house and away from the possible leak.
- After leaving the area, have a grown-up call 911 or the gas company to report the leak.

DON'Ts

- Do not turn appliances or lights on or off.
- Do not use your phone near the smell.
- Do not strike a match or do anything that could create a spark. Sparks could trigger an explosion.
- Do not ignore it.
