Product Overview

Scholastic Phonics Booster Books are sound-controlled readers that allow second and third graders to practice and reinforce their developing phonics skills. These short, age-appropriate stories present a sequence of sounds and high-frequency words that increase in difficulty throughout the series. Children build fluency, experience early reading success, and increase their reading confidence.

Skills Practice

Phonics Booster Books can supplement any comprehensive reading program. The 36 books in Level A and 24 books in Level B provide beginning readers with many independent reading opportunities.

Phonics

- The series emphasizes high-utility vowels, consonants, and phonograms.
- Students read words with consonant blends, short vowels, digraphs, diphthongs, inflectional endings, and multiple spellings of the long vowels.
- Each book focuses on a new phonic element and incorporates elements and words that have been previously read.

Fluency

- The gradual introduction of new sounds and words, with constant repetition and practice, helps children read successfully and fluently.
- Phonics Booster Books contain short, natural-sounding text that supports fluent reading.
- Students reread books throughout the week to help them increase their reading rate.

Vocabulary

- The high-frequency words found in the *Phonics Booster Books* represent the most commonly found words in first- through third-grade reading materials.
- Each book presents new story words that help children develop their vocabulary in context.
- Independent reading of a variety of texts increases students' vocabulary.

Comprehension

The books expose children to a variety of genres and subject matter.

Motivation and Engagement
