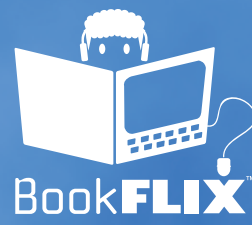

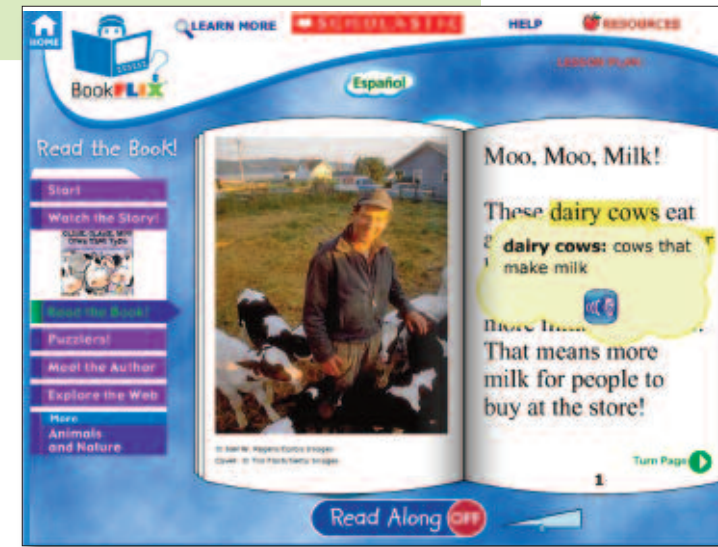
Read the Book!

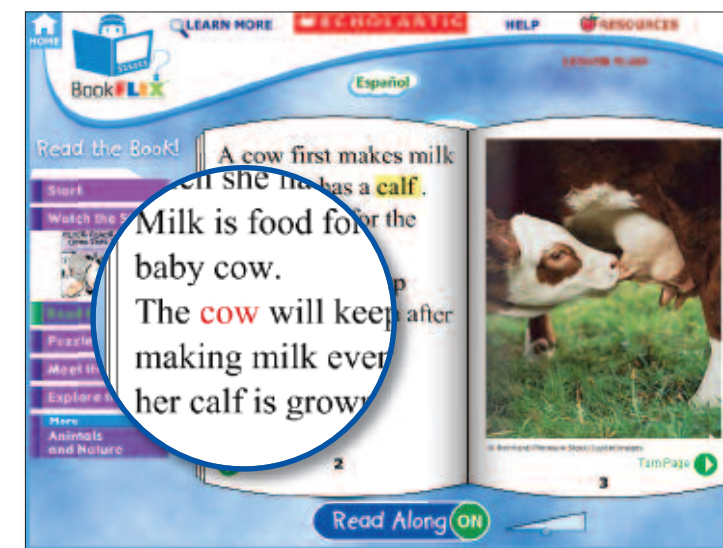
Interactive eBooks engage students with high-interest topics ranging from animals and nature to famous people and places so students learn to read for information.

Narrated text helps early readers, reluctant readers, and English Language Learners connect the spoken and written word.

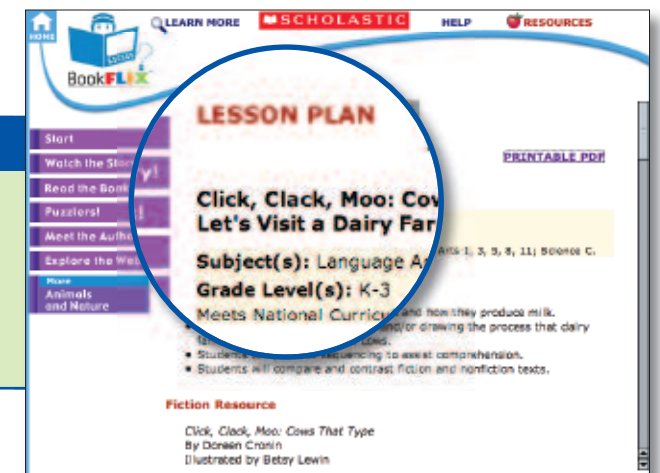

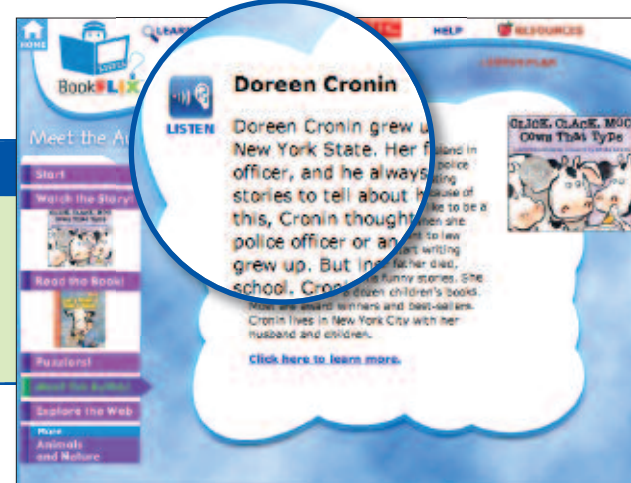

Author biographies introduce young readers to the writers behind the stories they love. Children can visit author Web sites and learn how their favorite stories were created.



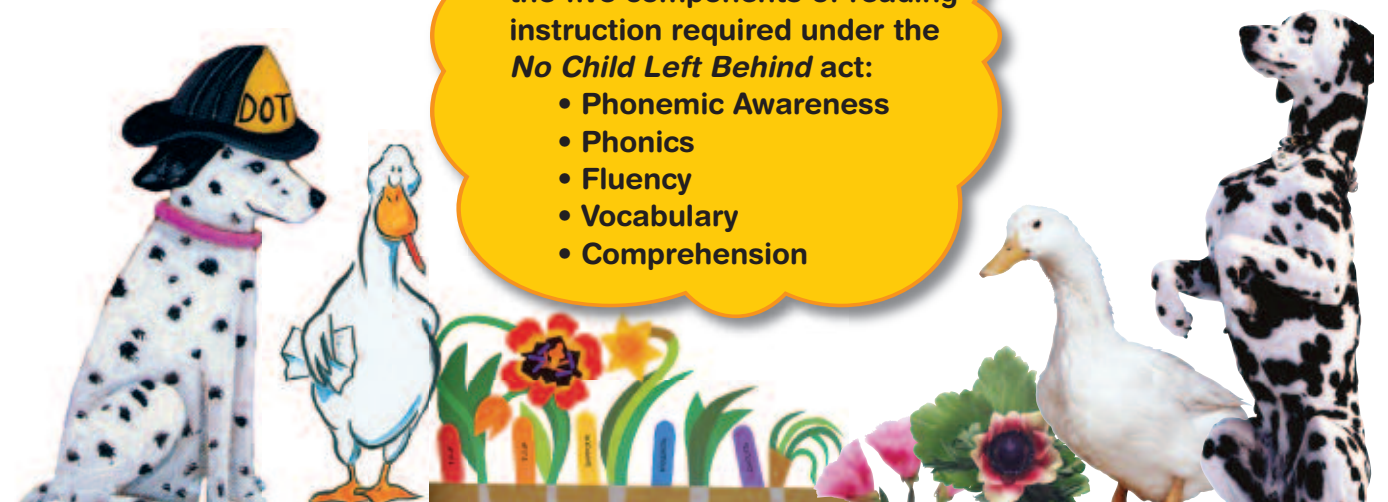

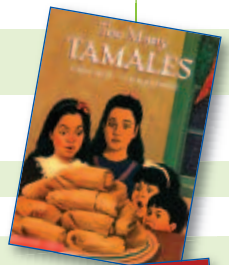
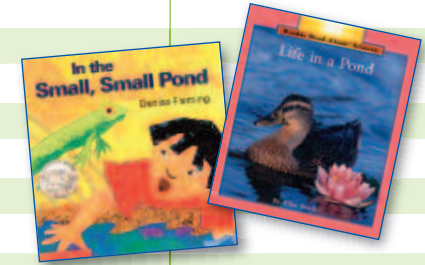

- Macromedia® Flash Player 9.0 or higher installed on every computer that will access BookFlix (this is a free download)

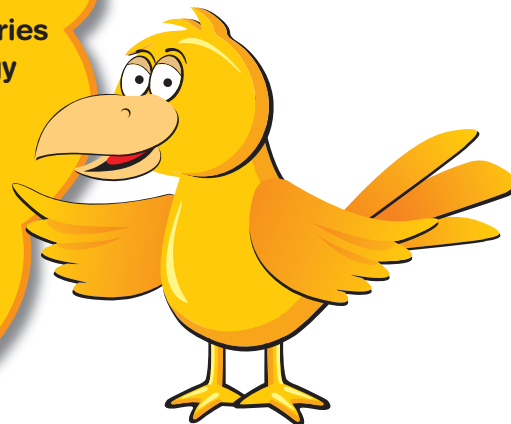
