

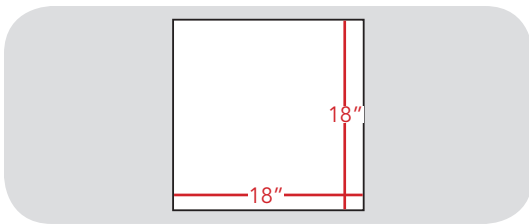
# Pyramid Table Sign Stand

## Supplies\*:

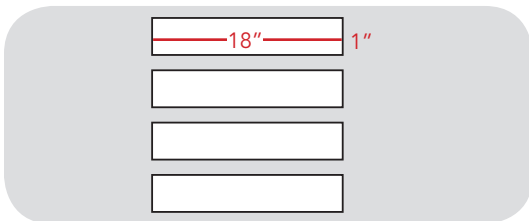
- 2 foam boards
- Duct tape (red, blue, gold)
- Masking tape
- Utility knife
- 18" or longer ruler



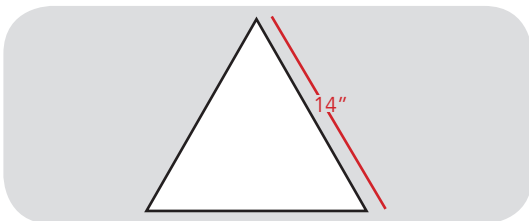
## Directions:



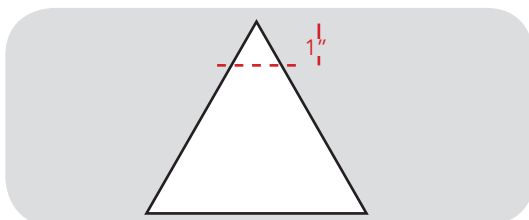
1. Using the utility knife and a ruler, cut out an 18" x 18" square from foam board. This will be used for the base of the stand. *(For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife. Never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)*



2. Cut out four 1" x 18" pieces of foam board. These pieces will be used for the sides.



3. Cut out four triangles that measure 14" equalateral.



4. Cut an inch off one of the three points of each triangle.

5. Attach the 1" foam strips to the perimeter of the 18" square base. Stand the foam strips on the edge of the base and tape along the edge, folding the extra tape under the base.
6. Use masking tape to reinforce the corners.
7. Embellish the edges of the square base with red, blue, and gold duct tape.
8. To make the pyramid, place a strip of masking tape on a flat surface, sticky side up, and adhere the edge of one triangle to half of the tape, leaving the sticky side of the other half exposed.
9. Adhere the edge of another triangle to the exposed half of the tape, making sure that the trimmed triangle tips match up (this will be the top of your pyramid). Press firmly to secure the tape.
10. Repeat steps 8–9 for two more edges of the pyramid, but do not attach the first and last sides to each other to close the pyramid yet.
11. Decorate your pyramid with horizontal strips of masking tape to create a sandy, stepped look, and top it off with a strip of gold duct tape wrapped around the top.
12. Wrap the four sides of your pyramid around a wire table stand that is sent in your Setup Kit and then secure the last edge with masking tape so that the top of the wire table stand is sticking out of the top of your pyramid.
13. Place the appropriate category table sign in your stand and make it the centerpiece of a merchandised table. Lean books up against each side of the pyramid as another way to draw shoppers to that table.
14. At the end of your Fair, remember to remove your wire table stand and send it back packed in the Setup Kit box.

\*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use whatever supplies you have on-hand for substitutions.
