

# All for Books™ Book Fair-oh Coin Challenge Containers

## Supplies\*:

- Loose change collection containers for each grade level
- Computer and printer
- Book Fair-oh headdresses (printed from pages 2-4 of these instructions)
- Teacher photos
- Glue stick
- Clear tape
- Hieroglyphic borders (printed from page 5 of these instructions)
- Grade level emblems (printed from page 6 of these instructions)
- Scrap foam board or cardboard



## Directions:

1. Print the Book Fair-oh headdresses from pages 2-4 of these instructions and cut them out.
2. Print teacher headshots large enough to fill the empty space within each headdress and glue a different teacher photo to each headdress.
3. Print and cut out the hieroglyphic borders from page 5 of these instructions and tape around each coin collection container.
4. Print the appropriate grade level emblems from page 6 of these instructions and glue to the corresponding teacher's headdress.
5. Cut a strip of foam board or cardboard and tape to the back of each Book Fair-oh head to make an easel similar to the back of a free-standing picture frame. Set each headdress on top of your coin collection containers and secure with clear tape.
6. Place the loose change collection containers for each grade level at your Book Fair (or in prominent spots throughout the school if beginning your challenge before the Fair).
7. Advertise your coin challenge and award the winning grade level with a privilege like homework passes or a pizza party.

\*Remember, these are only suggestions. These containers should be fun and creative, so use whatever supplies you have on-hand for substitutions.
