## **Giant All-Star Trophy**

## Supplies\*:

- Plastic outdoor trash can with lid
- Five-gallon plastic bucket (handle removed)
- Electric drill
- Screws with nuts and washers
- Zip ties
- Marker
- Foam board
- Utility knife
- Gold glitter
- Tacky glue
- Gold duct tape
- Gold spray paint
- Red metallic star



## **Directions:**

- 1. Place the trash can on top of the five-gallon bucket which is turned bottom up. Attach the two together by drilling holes through both of the bottoms and securing using screws with nuts and washers.
- 2. Place the trashcan/bucket combo on top of the trash can lid as shown in the photo. Drill corresponding holes in the side of the bucket and the trash can lid.
- 3. Attach the lid to the bucket by running zip ties through the holes just drilled. Tighten zip ties.
- 4. Place the foam board on top of the trashcan and trace a large circle with a marker. Using the utility knife, cut out the circle from the foam board to be the trophy lid. (For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife. Never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)
- 5. Cut trophy handles from leftover foam board using the photo as a guide.
- 6. Glitter the lid and handles of the trophy with glue and glitter. Let dry.
- 7. Cover the edges of the glittered lid and handles with gold duct tape. Set aside.
- 8. Cover the entire trashcan trophy cup with gold spray paint. Let dry.
- 9. Embellish the front of the trashcan trophy cup with gold glitter and a red metallic star.
- 10. Attach the glittered handles and lid to the cup with gold duct tape.
