

# Scoreboard Goal Chart

## Supplies\*:

- Black tri-fold presentation board
- Colored paper
- Colored paint
- Paintbrushes
- All-Star Book Fair logo (downloaded and printed from Fair Files/Clip Art in the Toolkit)
- Foam stars
- Scissors
- Glue
- Silver duct tape
- Labels and numbers (printed from the following pages of these instructions)
- Double-stick tape
- Fishing line and paper clips (for hanging)
- Step-stool





## Directions:

1. Cover the top third of the presentation board with paper matching your school colors to make your header.
2. Paint or attach colored letters to spell out the name of your school in the center of the paper. Embellish the header with logos and stars.
3. Frame the edges of the scoreboard and header with silver duct tape.
4. Print the scoreboard labels and numbers from the following pages of these instructions.
5. Using the photo and following template as a guide, attach the labels and numbers to your scoreboard with double-stick tape to indicate your goal or progress. Print multiple copies of the numbers to get the digit combinations you need.
6. Use the fishing line and paper clips to hang the goal chart scoreboard from the ceiling.
7. Have an adult volunteer gently peel off old numbers and double-stick tape new numbers to indicate progress toward your goal.

\*Remember, these are only suggestions. This goal chart should be fun and creative, so use whatever supplies you have on-hand for substitutions.
