



## Discussion Questions for The Honest Truth by Dan Gemeinhart

- 5. Mark talks about holding memories in his mind. What special memories do you have saved in your mind?

- 6. What does Mark explain to Wesley about the kid that ran away?
- 7. There was one call to the hotline about Mark's whereabouts. Do you think Wesley or Jessie made the call? Explain.
- 8. The trip took a toll on Mark's body, but in the hospital his eyes had more life than ever. Why do you think his eyes were full of life?
- 9. Mark says that anger only makes sense when you are stuck in the middle of it. What do you think this means? Have you ever been stuck in the middle of anger?
- 10. What does Jessie mean about the two truths about Mark's trip up the mountain? Have you ever been in a situation where there were two truths? Explain.
